However, I did put the panels around a plumbing vent that was sticking up at same height as panels - no shadow issues and was able to avoid the furnace exhaust.

I came here to post exactly this. I've read that solar panels can go right above plumbing vents and passive roof vents. I think I may have read somewhere that they are not supposed to go ...

The vent through the roof can screw up the placement of a solar panel, especially photovoltaic solar panels. Most solar panels are mounted about 5 in. above the roof's surface. So if a ...
