How much does it cost to live in Brazzaville?

The average cost of living in Brazzaville is \$597, which is in the top 15% of the least expensive cities in the world, ranked 7858th out of 9294 in our global list and 1st out of 6 in the Congo. The median after-tax salary is \$420, which is enough to cover living expenses for 0.7 months.

Does Congo Brazzaville have hydropower?

Hydropower accounted for 25% Congo Brazzaville's total installed electricity capacity in 2021. As of early 2024, the country had three hydropower plants. Congo Brazzaville has significant hydropower potential, estimated at 3.9 GW, but only 5% of this power has been developed.

Does Congo Brazzaville have natural gas?

Most of Congo Brazzaville's hydrocarbons production is located offshore. Congo Brazzaville holds sizable proved natural gas reserves, but only a small portion of the reserves is commercialized because of a lack of natural gas infrastructure.
