

# Huawei withdraws from solar inverters

Brussels-based renewable lobby group SolarPower Europe has expelled Chinese electronics giant Huawei from its members amid an ongoing EU bribery investigation into the company.

The decision to ban Huawei from the UK's 5G networks in 2020 followed scrutiny of the company's links to Beijing and fears its equipment could be used for espionage.
