The city is predominantly Sinhalese Buddhist, but also home to vibrant communities of Sri Lankan Moors (Muslims), Sri Lankan Tamils, and Christians, reflecting its pluralistic and inclusive character.

His reign, spanning until 1467, marked the kingdom's zenith, with Kotte controlling significant territories across southwestern Sri Lanka and briefly achieving broader unification under Sinhalese rule.[5]

In 1391, following the conquest of the Kingdom of Jaffna by Prince Sapumal (Sembahap Perumal), Kotte was given the epithet "Sri Jayawardenepura" ("resplendent city of growing victory"). It became the ...
