To calculate the ITC, you multiply the applicable tax credit percentage by the "tax basis," or the amount spent on eligible property. Eligible property includes the following: Solar PV panels, inverters, ...

Many states have either a solar or wind exemption, which provides that equipment used for electricity generation by either solar or wind be exempt from sales tax.

As a consumer, you owe tax on the cost to you of materials you provide and install in the performance of a construction contract. If the solar components you provide and install are considered fixtures, ...
