Up to 26 percent of Viet Nam's population can access to 5G services, according to the Ministry of Science and Technology. The current network of 5G base stations accounts for ...

To date, the country has only 11,591 5G base stations; 26% of the population has access to 5G services.

Vietnam's three major mobile operators have collectively rolled out 11,000 5G base stations, and the government expects that figure to nearly double by the end of 2025.

Vietnam's Ministry of Science and Technology (MOST) has mandated telecom providers to deploy at least 68,457 5G base stations by the end of 2025 -- a figure equivalent to 57.5 per cent of the ...

The 4G network currently covers 99.8% of the population, and the density of 5G stations is expected to increase significantly, from 7.72% to 57.5% 4G station density by the end of 2025.

Vietnam expects to deploy more than 68,000 5G base stations this year alone, equivalent to 57.5% of current 4G stations and sufficient to meet the coverage goal.

Among Vietnam's major telecom providers, Viettel has emerged as the dominant player, accounting for more than 80% of all 5G base stations deployed. These figures were released at the ...
