The spectrum release, approved by the NICTA Board in July 2025, sets the stage for 5G adoption. The minister concluded that this step would revolutionize mobile broadband and drive ...

The assignment of spectrum will be conducted through an open and transparent process, with commercial and business 5G services expected to launch in the second quarter of 2026.

The 2600 MHz band has been released for 5G services, which the minister said would bring vast opportunities for innovation, business investment, and inclusive growth.
