There are two MNOs in the market, Airtel and Gabon Telecom, who operate roughly equal shares of the market, with Gabon Telecom having 53% market share to Airtel's 47%.

Gabon has inaugurated its first utility-scale solar project. The PV plant is located in the Plaine-Ayeme area of northwestern Gabon, around 30 km from the country's ...

In terms of telecommunications, Gabon boasts one of the highest mobile phone penetration rates in Africa, largely due to the presence of three major operators: Airtel Gabon, Azur, and Moov Gabon.

Moov Africa Gabon Telecom and Airtel Gabon dominate the mobile market in 2025, each with roughly half the subscribers, offering 2G/3G/4G nationwide and no commercial 5G yet.
