

Windhoek solar energy policy

The City of Windhoek's 25-megawatt solar power project is at an advanced stage, with recommendations soon to be submitted to the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) board for consideration.

Once established, the Windhoek Solar Centre will operate as an independent information and knowledge hub, aimed at promoting and adopting solar energy technologies throughout Windhoek.

Approved in June 2023 by the UMDF Oversight Committee, the "Informal Settlement Renewable Electrification and Upgrading Program"; will facilitate electrification of 50,000 households ...
